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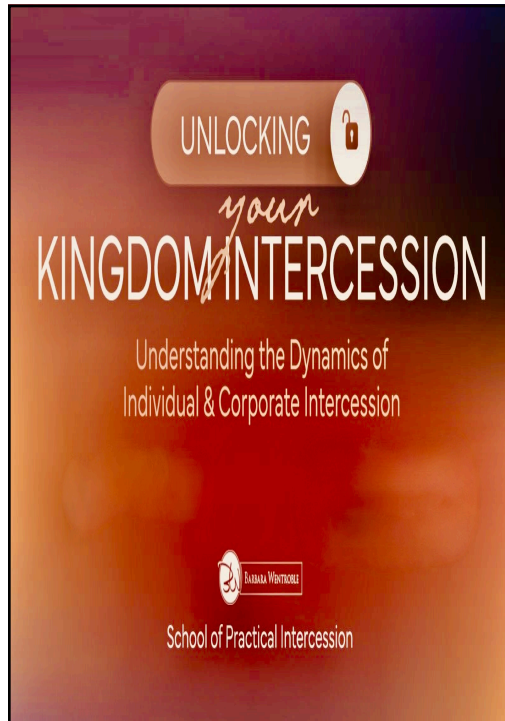
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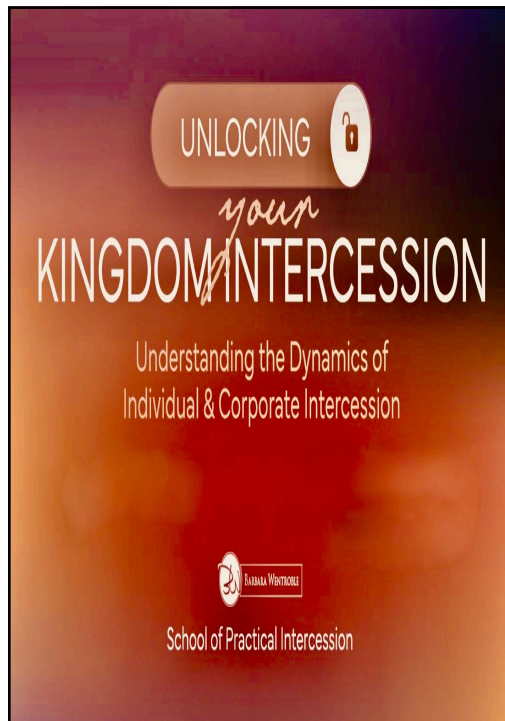

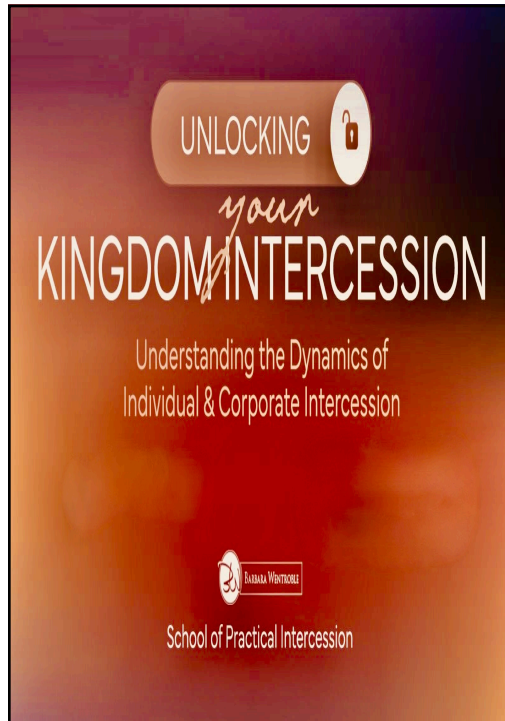

## What is Honor?

### Honor is a Noun and Verb

#### Noun:

1a: good name or public esteem : REPUTATION

2: PRIVILEGE

3a person of superior standing

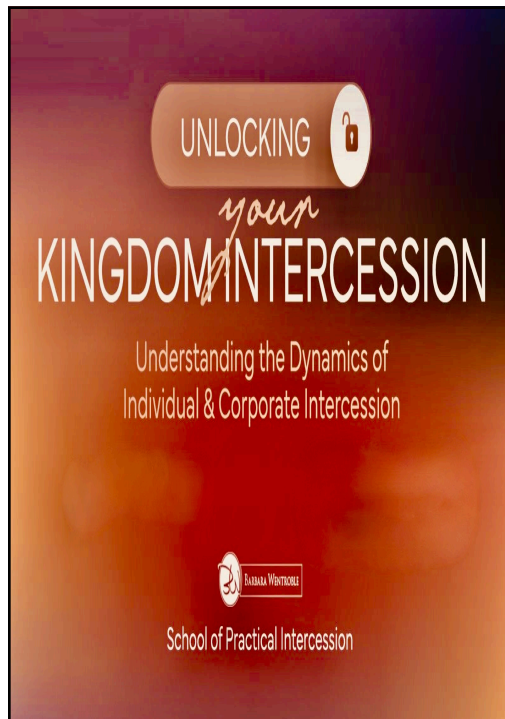

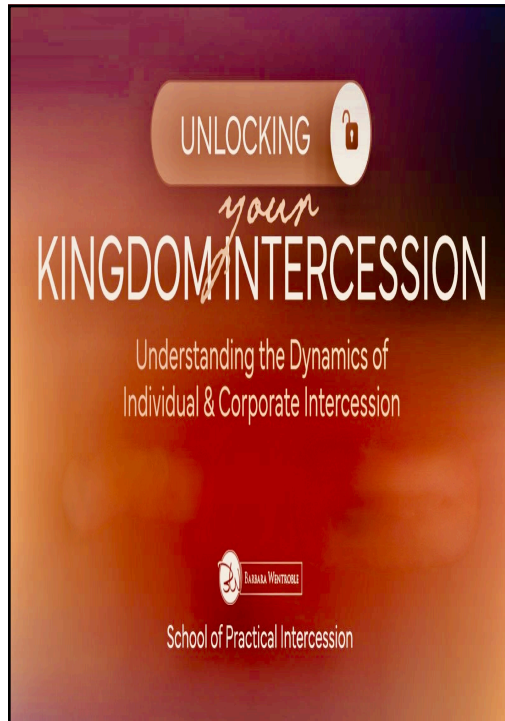
## What is Honor?

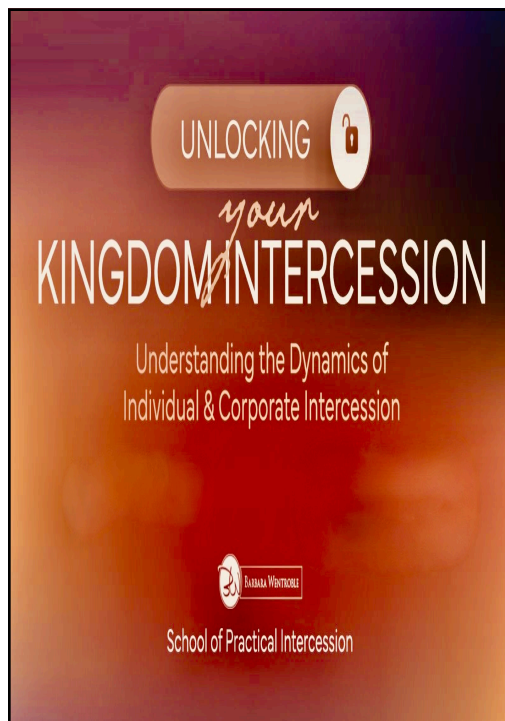

#### Kavod (Strong's H3519)

- 1. **glory, honour, glorious, abundance**
  - a. **abundance, riches**
  - b. **honour, splendour, glory**
  - c. **honour, dignity**

  - e. **honour, reverence, glory**
  - f. **glory**

כָּבוֹד *kâbôwd*, kaw-bode'; rarely כְּבוֹד *kâbôd*; from [H3513](#); properly, weight, but only figuratively in a good sense, splendor or copiousness:—glorious(-ly), glory, honour(-able).

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### What does Scripture say about Honor

#### Kabad (Strong's H3513)

**to be heavy, be weighty, be grievous, be hard, be rich, be honourable, be glorious, be burdensome, be honoured**

**a. (Qal)**

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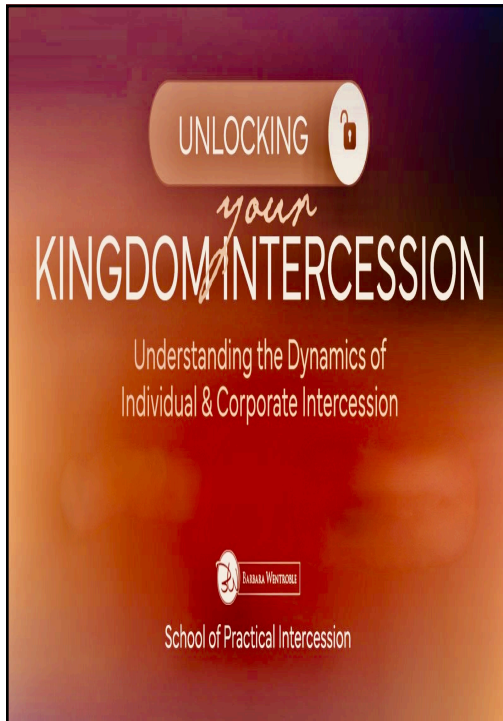

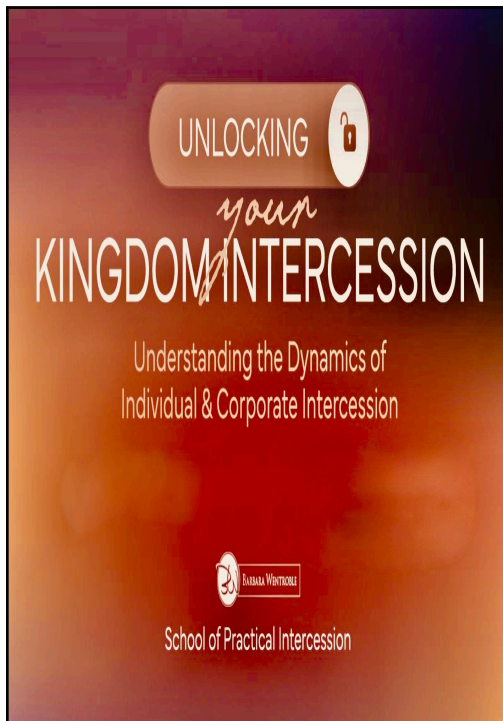

**Honor, heavy** כבוד ka-vod  
 In ancient times the concept of value was judged by weight. What was heavy had great worth. Honor is the Biblical door to great friendship, love, community and blessings. The word for honor in Hebrew is the word for "heavy."  
 The word picture says that when I treat someone with great value that the honor given is...

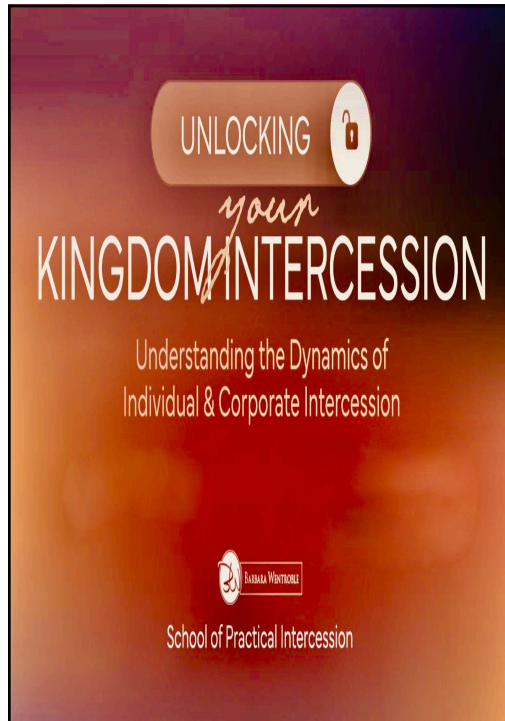

 Alef א - house, inner  
 Dalet ד - door

When someone that matters treats you as if you are worth millions or with great value, what happens? Your inner heart always opens.  
 Without honor, love is entertainment based - how I feel - and is easily gained or lost. It is the delight and enjoyment of a child with a new toy. It is also the quick boredom that can follow.  
 This is why our culture is always falling in love with something of someone new, but never building solid foundations for our friendships, marriages and families.  
 This changes when it is not entertainment but value that determines our relationship. If I own a perfect copy of a Rembrandt, I will delight in it. I will enjoy it, but I might just as easily put it in the closet when I want something else. I treat it by my emotions because I do not see it as having great value.  
 But if I find out that it is the original worth millions of dollars, I would treat it with care, with honor. I would never put it in a corner, but always at the center.  
 Human nature and human relationships treat emotions as temporary, but honor as foundational.  
 What is heavy can also carry the opposite meaning. It is used when Pharaoh hardened his heart. If our heart does not learn honor, it will instead learn to harden against people and God. A hardened heart will destroy other people, relationships and ourselves.  
 In contrast, the word קללה ke-la-la or curse (see page 157) is what is light and has no value.

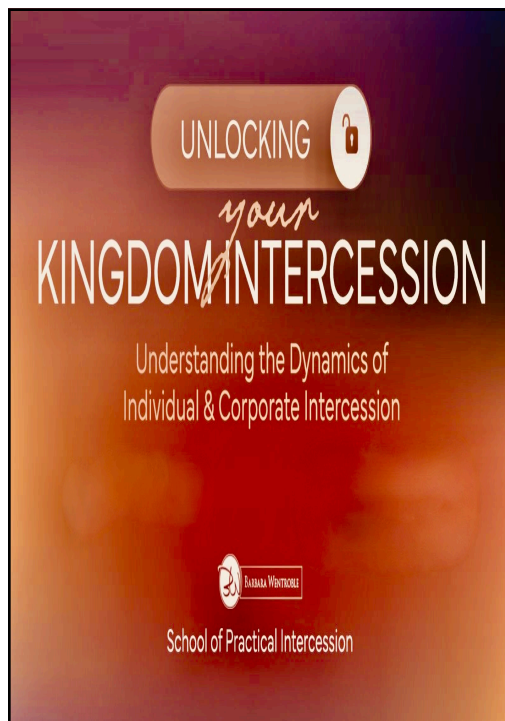

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



In other words, YHVH has assigned Honor with the task of empowering us, His sons, to govern: to rule the earth fully aware of our inheritance in Him. Remarkably, honor has the capacity to unlock the limitless potential for greatness in each of us. **When we give honor to friends or foes alike (or ourselves), we help facilitate alignment with their God-given potential and destiny; moreover, we co-labor with Heaven in YHVH's work of mercy and grace to bring out the best in everyone, even His enemies—keep in mind that "The Lord is ... not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance" (2 Peter 3:9). Honor's primary objective is redemption, not destruction."****





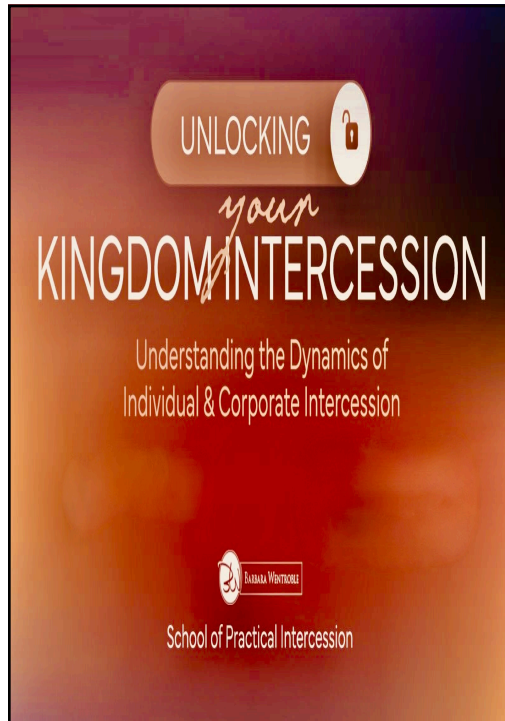
**Weaponized Honor: Tactical Love by Marios Ellinos**

"I want to know as much as I can about honor—to walk in it and to be clothed with it. I desire to grow in my ability to leverage honor for the advancement of God's Kingdom. **And that means learning not only how to give honor, but also how to receive it. Honor must flow unhindered by pride, inhibitions, or insecurities. Those who can only give honor, but cannot receive it, block it just as much as not being able to give it but only receive it.**"



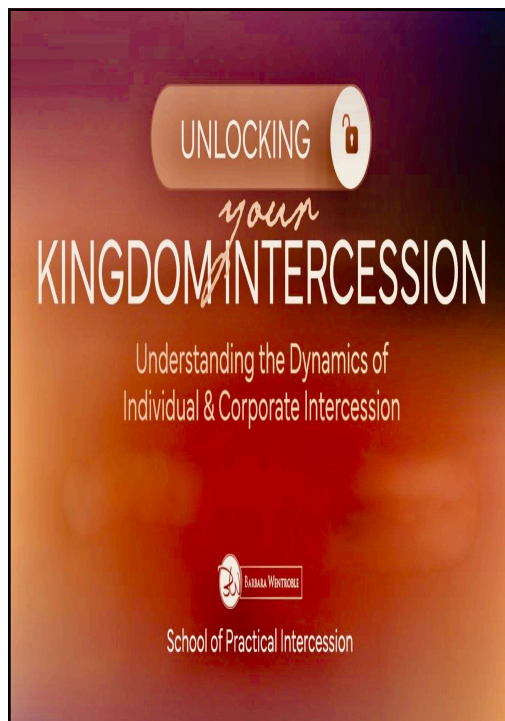
**Walking in Your Life's Purpose: The Power of DIP - Destiny, Identity, and Purpose by Barbara Wentroble**

"**Passion defines purpose.** Discovering my purpose ignited my life in a new way. I understood why I was passionate about empowering others for their life's purpose. My passion defined my purpose! **If you are not passionate about something, it is probably not your purpose. Passion will also cause you to desire significance by creating a legacy for future generations. Your purpose is not merely about yourself. Your purpose always involves others. God is the God of generations. In the Bible, He refers to Himself as the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. These men represented three generations. Therefore, God is the God who created a legacy by causing His blessings to flow through the generations. His desire is for us to be like Him and see that our purpose is generational!**

**V7: You give him dominion over the work of Your hands; You have placed everything beneath his feet.**

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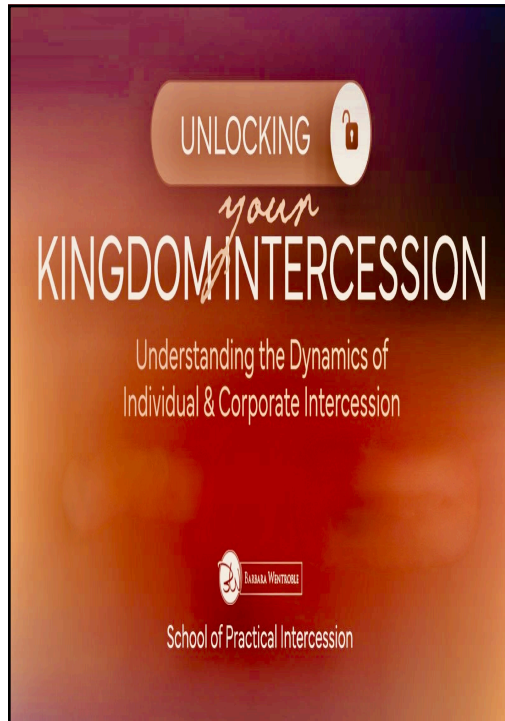

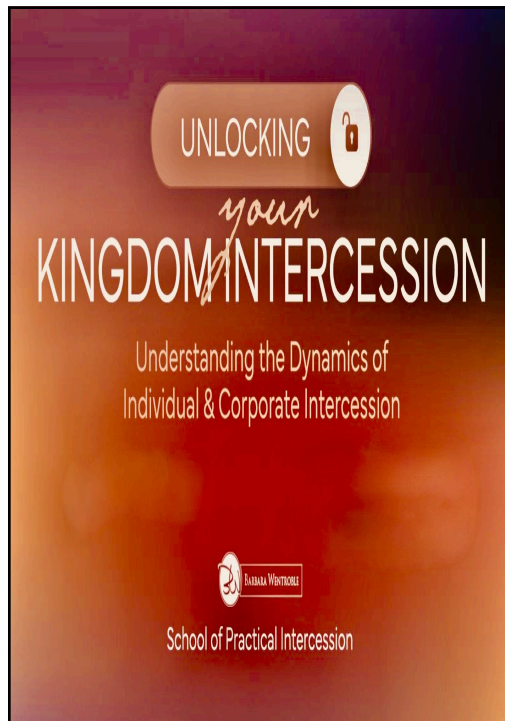
## Proverbs 25:2

It is the glory of God to conceal a matter; to search out a matter is the glory of kings (NIV). Glory is Kavod in this scripture.

**Tanakh\*: The honor of God is to conceal a matter, whereas the honor of kings is to search out a matter.**

\*Tanakh, an acronym derived from the names of the three divisions of the Hebrew Bible: Torah (Instruction, or Law, also called the Pentateuch), Nevi'im (Prophets), and Ketuvim (Writings).


**Develop of your relationship with Him: Recognize He desire to relate to you is immeasurable.**

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
