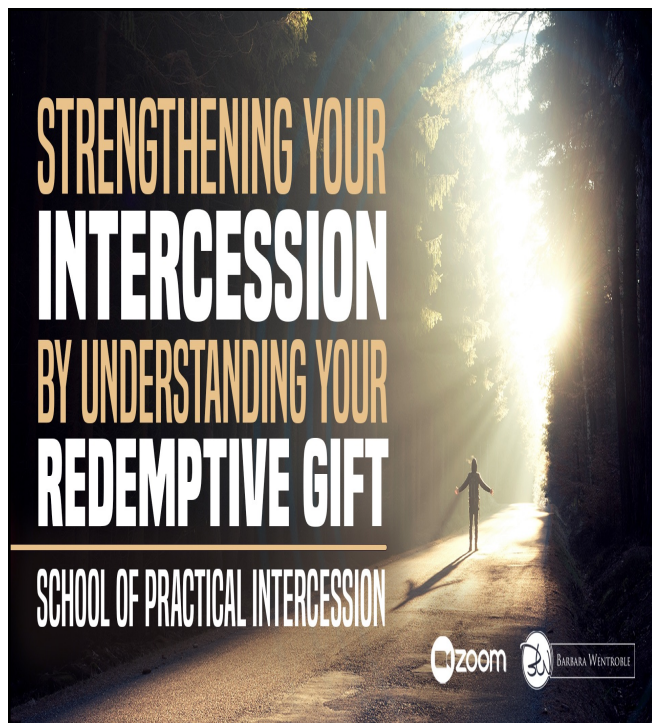


# What is the “why” of this particular course?

The “why and what” of “Revelation” or what God is unveiling.

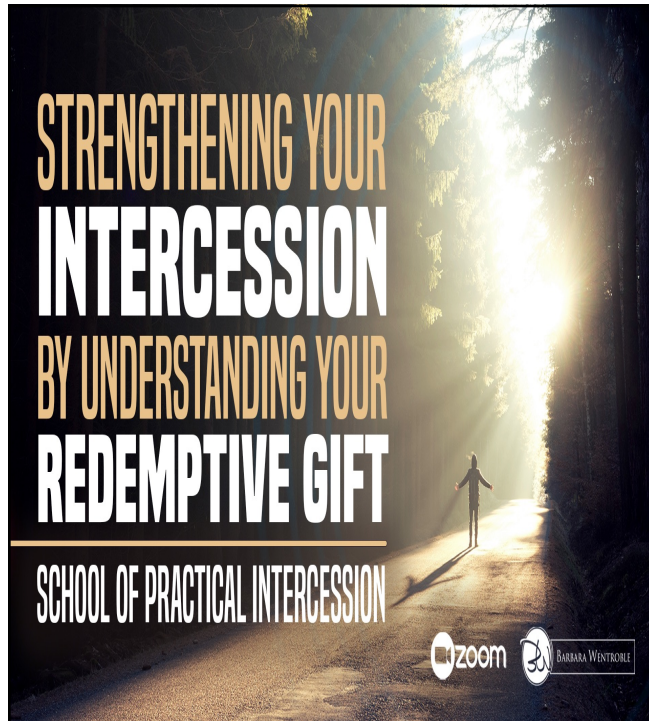

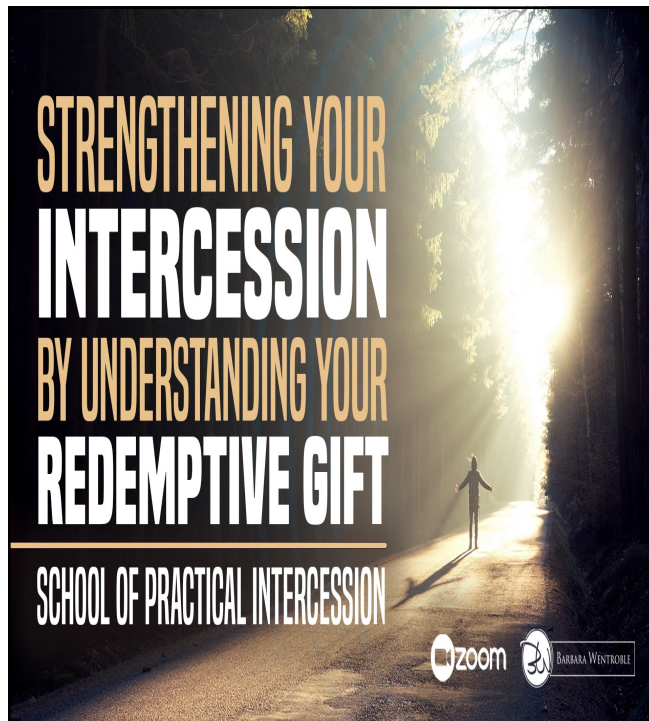

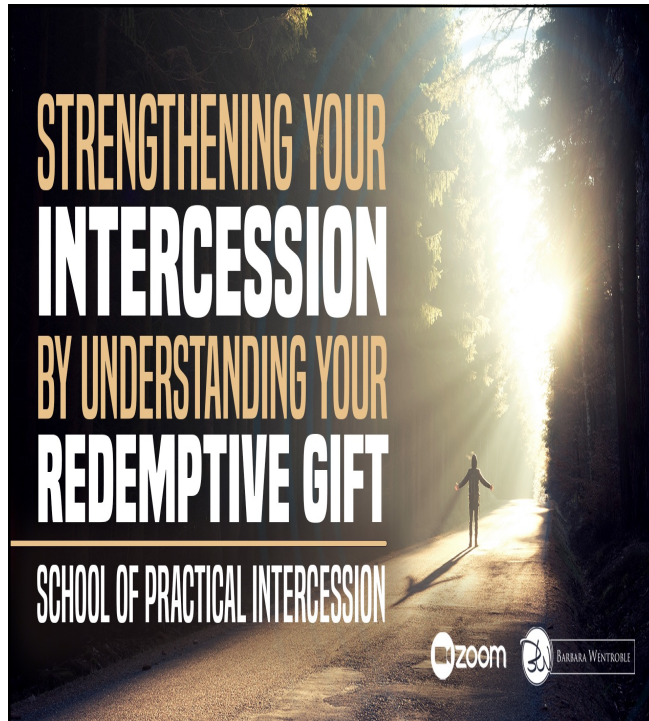
- 1. As a SOPI Instructor, I expressed my desire to see SOPI participants walk in new levels of responsibility and authority in their Intercession.**

**Understanding we are Kings and Priest of the Most High God**

**Revelation 1:5-6 (NKJV) declares:**

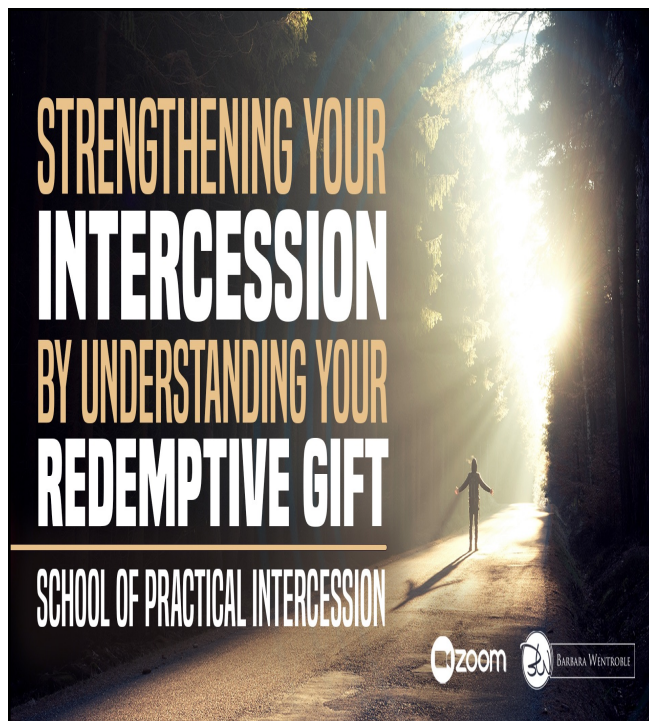
**And from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made **us kings and priests** to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen**



## Understanding we are Kings and Priest of the Most High God

### What does this mean?

1. As priests, He is inviting us to have an intimate relationship with Him. It is in this place we hear His heart and desires for our lives. He is also asking us to join the choirs of Heaven to worship Him.
2. As Kings, He has given us the responsibility of partnering with Heaven to see His heart manifest on the earth. He has shared the honor to rule, reign, legislate, and steward the resources of Heaven with Him. So, the knowledge of His glory covers the earth as the waters cover the sea.



## Why Redemptive Gifts?

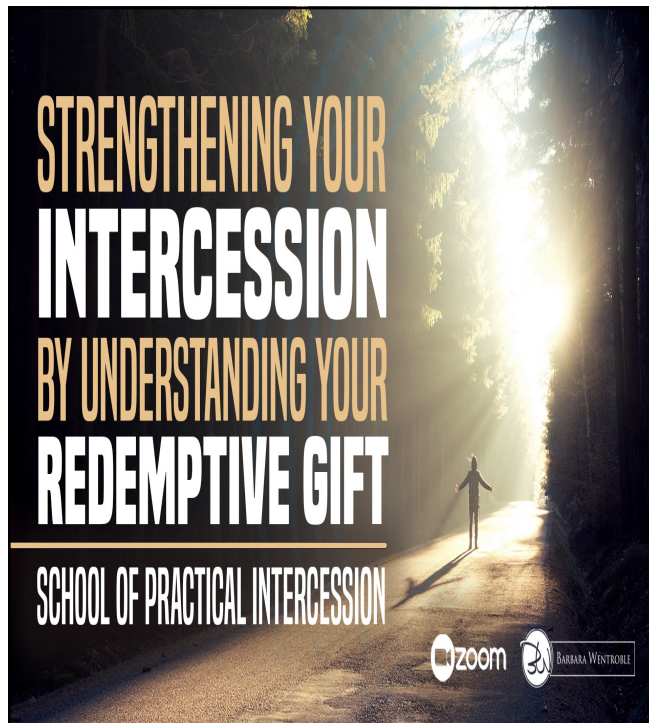
The answer is found in a brief survey of the books of Romans.

In Romans 1:11 (Passion Translation), Paul proclaims one of his objectives in his letter to the Ekklesia of Rome:

**I yearn to come and be face-to-face with you and get to know you. For I long to impart to you some spiritual gift that will empower you to stand strong in your faith.**

**Note regarding the seed of impartation:**

**When we receive an impartation, we have the responsibility to nurture it to maturity.**

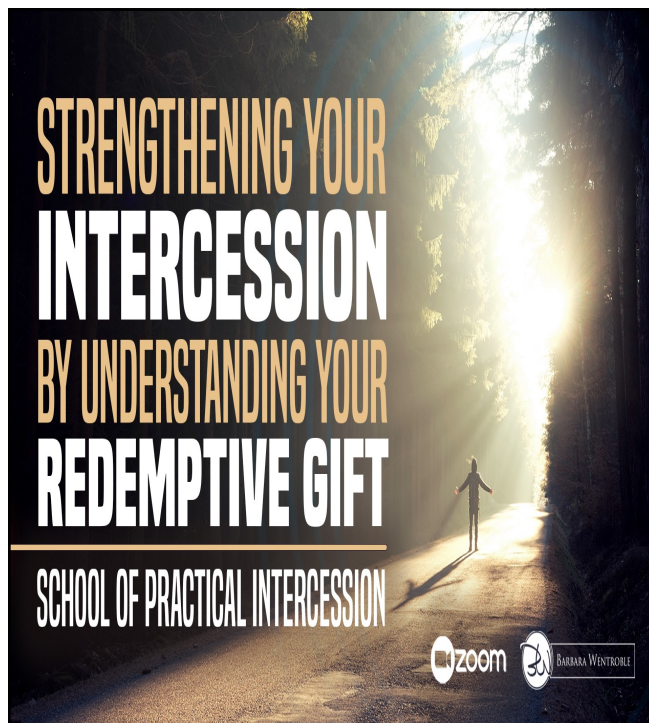


## Why Redemptive Gifts?

Romans 8:5, 11,19 (TPT), 37-38

**5:** Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.

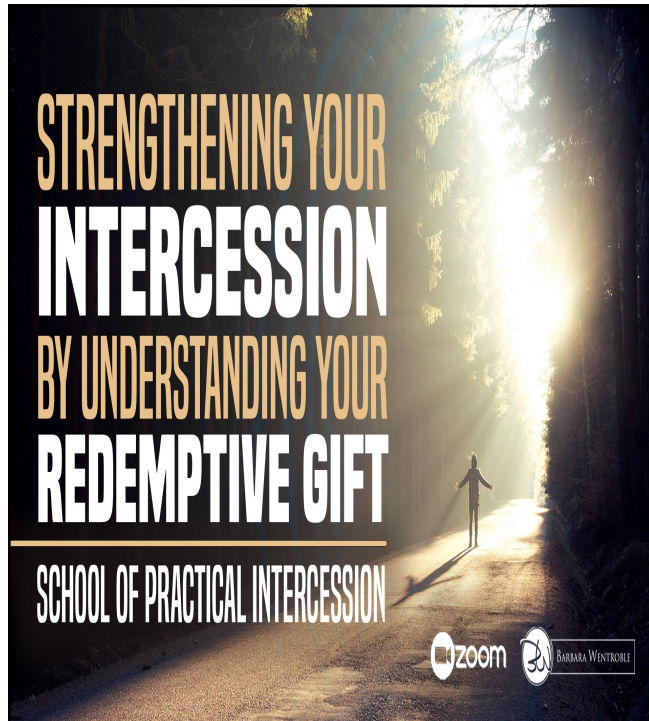
**11:** And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.

**19 (Passion):** The entire universe is standing on tiptoe, yearning to see the unveiling of God's glorious sons and daughters!

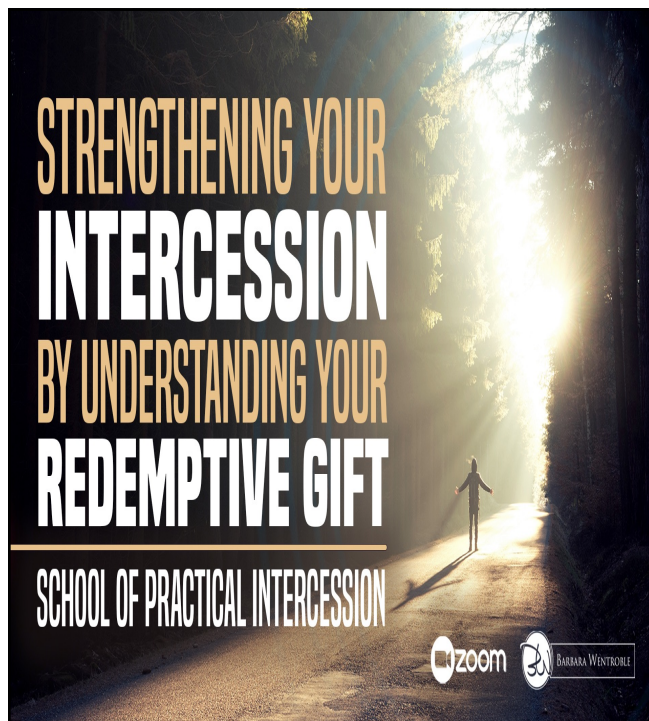
**37-39 (NKJV):** Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.



## Why Redemptive Gifts?

**Romans 12:1-8 (Mirror):**

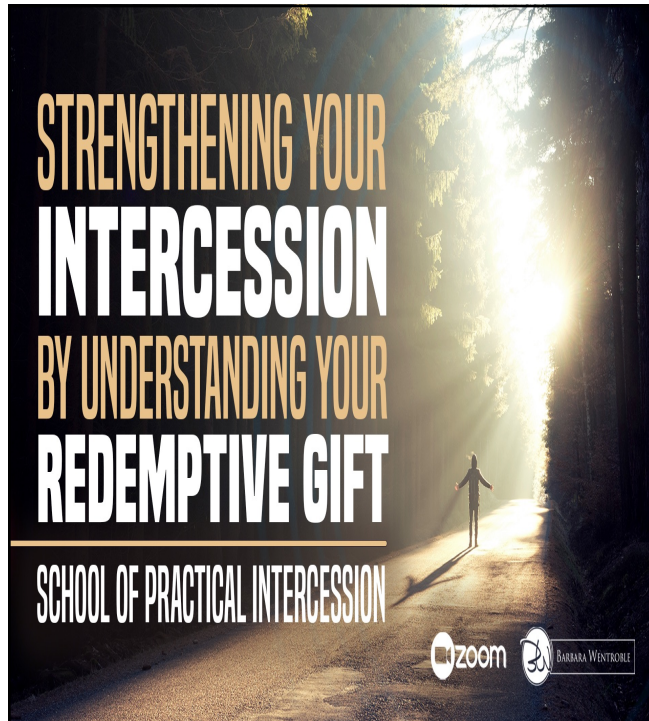
Live consistent with who you really are, inspired by the loving kindness of God. My brothers, the most practical expression of worship is to make your bodies available to him as a living sacrifice; this pleases him more than any religious routine. He desires to find visible, individual expression in your person. "Do not allow current religious tradition to mold you into its pattern of reasoning. Like an inspired artist, give attention to the detail of God's desire to find expression in you. Become acquainted with perfection. To accommodate yourself to the delight and good pleasure of him will transform your thoughts afresh from within His grace gift inspires me to say to you that your thinking must be consistent with everything that is within you according to the measure of faith that God has apportioned to every individual.



## Why Redemptive Gifts?

**Romans 12:1-8 (Mirror):**

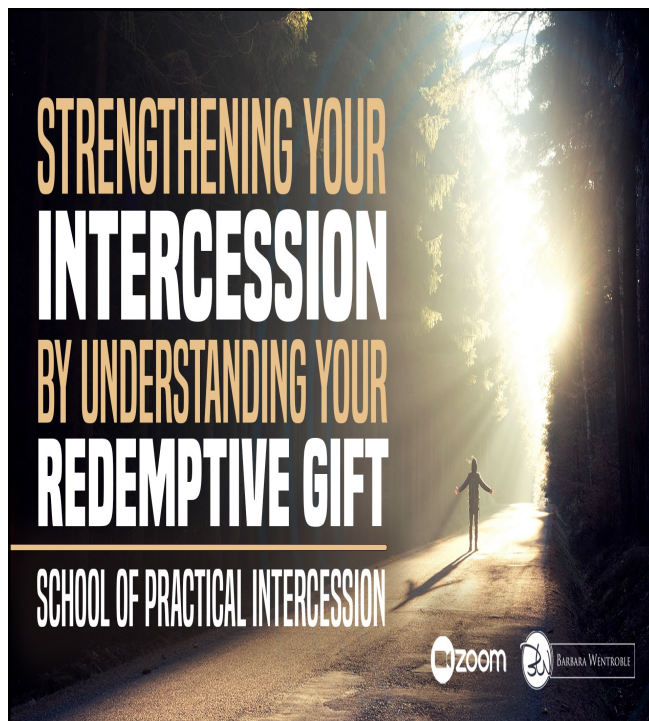
Let the revelation of redemption shape your thoughts. The parallel is clear. There are many different members in one body, yet not one competes with the other in function. Instead every individual member co-compliments the other. In Christ, the many individuals are all part of the same body and members of one another. Our gifts may differ in function, but his grace is the same. If it is your turn to prophesy, let faith and not a title be your inspiration. The same goes for every aspect of ministry, whether it be serving or to give instruction, or to just be there alongside someone to remind them of their true identity; always let faith set the pace. You are intertwined with your gift, wrapped up in the same parcel. Lead with passion; minister mercy cheerfully."
